For selection of an **ECONOMIST (E/1 position)**

within the Project Management Unit for Integrated Nutrient Pollution Control Project

Ministry of Waters and Forests seeks recruitment of suitable staff to cover the Project Assistant position with an employment contract for a limited period within the Project Management Unit (PMU) responsible with the implementation of the World Bank (WB) supported Additional Financing of the Integrated Nutrient Pollution Control Project (INPCP-AF). Through the Additional Financing the overall development objective of the Project became to support the Government of Romania towards meeting the EU Nitrate Directive requirements at a national scale. The proposed interventions will build on the successes and lessons learned from the initial Project as well as from similar projects in Europe and Central Asia and other regions.

General Description:

- a. The Economist is responsible for financial management in accordance with the Romanian legislation in force and World Bank regulations.
- b. The Economist is subordinated and reports to the Financial Manager.

The individual employment contract will be concluded for a limited period of time, until 31.03.2022.

The minimum required qualifications are:

- university degree in economics;
- at least 3 years of experience in the field of public finance;
- practical experience in project implementation is a plus;
- sound knowledge of national legislation which is applicable in the financial, accounting and budget fields;
- practical experience in the budgeting process, procurement and contracting procedures;
- practical experience in internal and external preventive financial control procedures;
- basic knowledge of the World Bank procedures and financial requirements; experience in working with the World Bank is a plus;
- relevant experience in producing financial reports to a large number of institutions;
- advanced PC skills and sound knowledge of the MS Office package: MS Word, Excel, Access, Outlook, Power Point;
- ability to work in a team;
